Average medical cost of fatal and non-fatal injuries by type in the USA

A new study was carried out in the USA to estimate the average medical care cost of fatal and non-fatal injuries. The average medical cost of all fatal injuries was approximately \$6880 for Emergency Department based patients and \$41 570 for hospital-based patients. The article concludes that injuries are costly and preventable and cost effective public health prevention activities are needed to overcome the economic burden of injuries.
